Justice & Advocacy Team meets at noon today. **Young Adults Gathering, 6pm** The Beet Café at Ellwood Thompson.

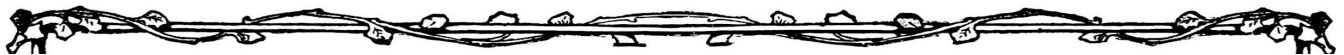
Ministry Council meets next Sunday, October 29 at noon. **All Saints All Sing** is Nov. 5 at 6pm
